He also spent five seasons with Kelvin Sampson at the University of Oklahoma.

5:00-5:50 Kyle Smith: Coach Smith enters his first year as the head men's basketball coach at Washington State, bringing with him nine years of head coaching experience to the Palouse along with 18 years as an assistant coach. The last three seasons he was at the helm of the University of San Francisco men's program. There he compiled 20 wins every year and two post season tournaments. Before that he led Columbia University to a CIT championship and post season appearances. Coach Smith refined these skills with 18 years of assistant coaching at Saint Mary's, Air Force Academy and University of San Diego.

(In case Coach Smith get called out on a recruiting trip) Derrick Phelps-Coach Phelps enters his first season as assistant coach at Washington State and his sixth on Kyle Smith staff. He spent the last three as the associate head coach at the University of San Francisco and the prior two years as an assistant coach at Columbia. Phelps also assisted at Monmouth and Fordham. As a member of the North Carolina men's team, Phelps won the 1993 National Championship, playing under legendary Dean Smith.
