Teaches to play fast but also get a good shot. 3's in transition.

Zone Defense Situations

Deny or take away an option - high post, 3 ball from a shooter etc. Extend the entire zone and don't allow 3.

Don't leave the paint unless you're guarding the ball. Etc

Force the bounce with the weak hand push to the weak direction don't "turn em." keep them on their uncomfortable side. Zig zag drill daily

Front post with smaller guard. Ferris ex,

ALSO- mix up defenses – players get comfortable finding space or spots in the zone then u show a different look and they are lost. 1-2-2 or man etc

Some areas where the zone has struggled.

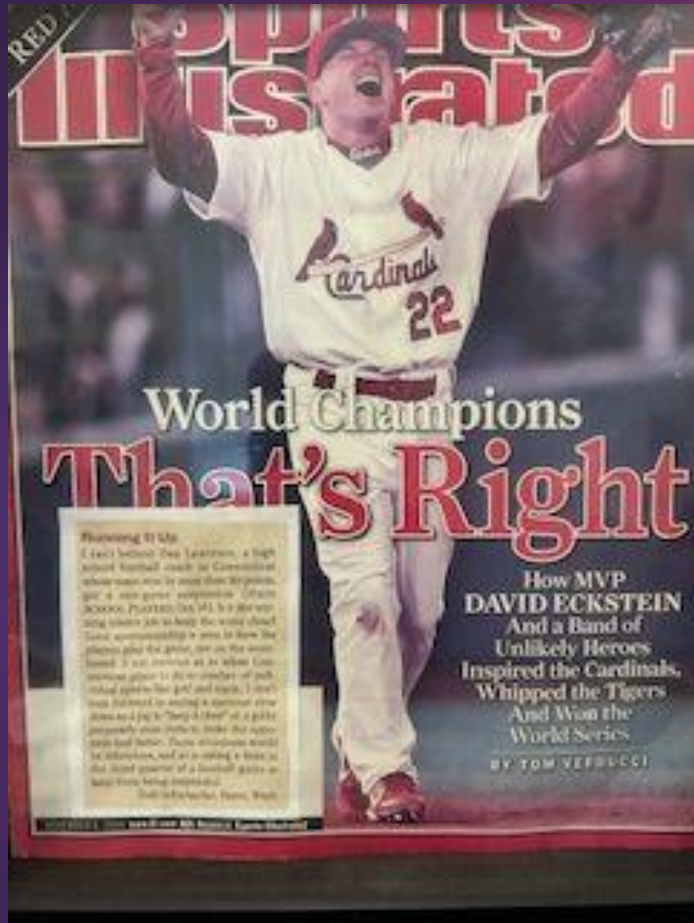
Hot shooting perimeter- Davenport, Colfax, NW Christian

Team Rotations Situations

Teams, relationships, rules – Let kids pick teams sometimes for scrimmage. They will show you who they think the best players are and who they like to play with. KYP – 6'10 post comes off the bench , start a 6'2 post in place. State title game winner etc

Know your team's needs- you may need a guard and not a 4th post etc.

Rules- rules/consequences

Treat each situation individually.

Different home life situations -
